For those who like to cook, have a bake off in your troop. Have each girl bake something for a meeting and invite "judges" (not parents). To judge them based on design, creativity, and taste.

Invite another troop to join you.

Attend an upcoming Fashion Show. There should be one coming at Hara Arena.



Get your families together for an evening of fun at Hobart Arena for "family ice skating".



Develop a talent show within your troop. Make guidelines, have rehearsals and then put on a "Show" for the girls parents, grandparents and any other family member who would want to attend. If you want a larger scale event invite another troop or two to join your girls for this event.
