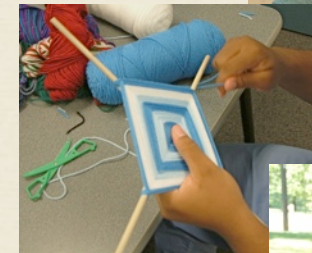

“Scouting For Badges” Overview

Is your Junior Girl Scout or Junior Girl Scout Troop looking for additional opportunities to complete badge requirements in a timely fashion? If so consider “Scouting For Badges” as a way to have a great time earning your badges and also meeting new friends in your community who are also interested in scouting.

The “Scouting For Badges” program provides step-by-step instructions and all the supplies needed to complete six of the requirements needed to fulfill a Junior Girl Scout badge. Class sessions generally last about three hours with a snack break provided midway through the class. The scouts or leaders are asked to provide their own drinks and snacks. This format makes the classes a perfect Junior Girl Scout activity or monthly meeting.

Each “Scouting For Badges” class description includes a list of the six badge requirements that will be covered during the class. A certification form signed by the instructor, which can be used to document completion of the specific badge requirements, is issued upon completion of the class. Scouts must arrive for the classes in a timely fashion, prior to the start of the class, and must complete the whole class-- no exceptions. Signed badge completion forms are issued only to scouts that complete the whole class.

“Scouting For Badges” classes are presented by Miami County artist Karen Purke, a teacher with over 30 years of teaching experience working with Pre- K through senior citizens. She herself is a product of the Girl Scout program, completing Brownies through Cadet level of scouting. Purke says “I developed the “Scouting For Badges” program to encourage and aid Scouts and their leaders to achieve their goals in earning badges through hands on experiences that are the foundation of badge programs. The Scouts fulfill the badge requirements themselves and have a lot of fun and I am there to prepare the projects and guide them along the way.”

Junior Girl Scout Folk Arts Badge:

This badge class will fulfill the following badge requirement:Family Portrait, Traditional Art, What Toys Tell Us, Folk Art Around the World, Fresh and Original and Time Travel.

Age Level : Junior Girl Scouts & Leaders

Minimum Scouts :10 Scouts individually registered or registered as a group with leaders. NOTE: Number of leaders do not count in the minimum needed for registration. **Maximum Scouts:** 20 Junior Girl Scouts & up to 10 leaders =30 total students.

Registration Fee: \$18.00 Junior Girl Scouts, Scout Leaders 18 years and older \$8.00. Registration and payment is required 10 days prior to the class .
