Choice of country is on a first-come first-served basis - please send your request early!

How does this work? If your troop is representing a country, you will need to arrive at the event at least a half hour early to set up your display. Your troop can set up their display however they want but it should show some of the unique things about the country and Girl Scouts/Girl Guides, such as: culture, food, crafts, songs, games played, uniforms, Girl Scout Promise/Law, etc.

This year we are asking that everyone donate a small amount of change to "buy" the food from each country. The service unit will then donate all of the money to WAGGGS. It will help girls and women worldwide!

After the opening ceremony at 12 p.m., the girls will begin their travel after they have received their passport. In the Passport Area, the girls will "apply" for a passport so that they can visit all of the countries represented. They will receive a map with their passports so that they can plot their course. The girls can take turns at their country's table to share information. Your troop also may want to make and trade SWAPS with others as they visit. We will end with a closing ceremony.
